On 06.09.2021, a meeting was organized in which all participants of the [COST CA 20139] research contract were present [...], the university's laboratories were visited and the equipment available for carrying out the researches were identified.

On 07.09.2021 visits to various sites were organized in order to explain the need to design sustainable constructions in Iceland;

On 08.09.2021, a meeting was organized with PhD supervisors within the University where it was decided to extend the collaboration with FAUT at the master and doctoral level and decided to also supervise joint PhD (cotutelle PhD) between the two universities in various research fields specific for architecture and civil engineering;

In order to disseminate the results of the future researches, to propose joint courses of the two universities and joint workshops, on 09.09.2021 various courses were held by the professors from Reykjavik who aimed to improve the knowledge of the UPT teaching staff and identify common ways of teaching in the field.

On 10.09.2021, meetings were made with representatives of the department of international relations in order to achieve future collaboration agreements in the field of architecture and civil engineering.
