

This was a great opportunity to visit a foreign country and get to live there for a short while and understand the different dynamics. It was also an opportunity for me to understand other teaching methods that are applied, which are quite different from ours, especially in terms of student-teacher communication and the freedom you are given to conceptualize your subject.

The main topics covered within the paper [written following the placement] integrate aspects regarding the way in which communities are shaped by the landscape they are surrounded by on a social, anthropological and identity level, the sensory aspects of experiences created through the landscape and which set of criteria stays at the basis of an ideal relationship between landscape and community. It is also an analysis of the intrinsic connections between the natural landscape and the built landscape and the implications these aspects have regarding the portrait of Norwegian communities.
