They have students from all over Norway and for them arriving to school is quite difficult in winter, because of the snow and big distances. Hybrid classes were very successful in order to help the students.

The topics of the talks and small lectures were mainly about: green development, green energy, energy saving, green roof, timber structures, building techniques, climate change, nature, and environmental measures. Each subject was developed with short presentations and examples.

In the last day I had the opportunity to be invited to a meeting in the International House from Oslo, with Jørn Lein-Mathisen (Founder International House) and Rita Anson (Project Manager Oslo International Hub), to discuss future Erasmus and EEA Grant opportunities.

This mobility broadened my field of interest, taking more into the account multidisciplinary and developing new projects and ideas for future collaborations with the University College of Green Development.
