We had meetings with representatives of the University and of the international office and we discussed new opportunities to sign EEA agreements and Erasmus in the field of environmental sciences and also in the field of electricity and energy. We had the opportunity to meet Prof. Dag Jørund Lønning, the Rector of HGUt.

For me, this mobility will contribute to an exchange of best practices regarding the teaching and research activity in the discipline Impact of Energy Installations on the Environment, as well as to the identification of potential partners from the academic and economic environment, in order to develop future partnerships.

Naturally, this mobility will help to strengthen the cooperation with the partner institution, HGUt, it will increase the visibility of UPT on the international level, as well as, following the dissemination of the results, it will help to stimulate the interest of teaching staff and students from UPT, regarding the objectives of this project and to the SEE grants.

Multidisciplinary issues related to the area of energy engineering, infrastructure for energy conversion, sustainable development, and the impact of human activities on the environment and communities will be discussed. These aspects have been too little highlighted so far within the disciplines at the partner institution.
